You must also meet applicable satisfactory academic progress requirements of your postsecondary institution and program.

NOTE: Only one year of an award will be made for a single career and technical certificate program, regardless of program length. The CTE APS award cannot be used for other degree types, such as associate's or bachelor's. Occupational endorsement certificates and private pilot's programs are also not eligible.

You may use the CTE APS to complete consecutive certificate programs. An APS may be used for no more than 8 semesters/12 quarters (4 academic years), for full-time or half-time attendance.
