The Alaska Legislature enacted the Alaska Performance Scholarship (APS) in 2011 to inspire and prepare our high school students for success in college and career training. Since inception, **30,695** Alaska high school graduates have completed the rigorous requirements and achieved APS eligibility.



#### APS prepares ALASKA STUDENTS FOR COLLEGE AND CAREER TRAINING

For every one APS-eligible graduate requiring developmental coursework, 12 non-recipients require developmental coursework.



### Did You Know?

- ★ APS can be used for university studies as well as career or technical training up to 6 years after high school graduation.
- APS recipients must meet Continuing Eligibility requirements while in college/training to continue receiving APS.
- ★ The APS is funded through earnings of the Alaska Higher Education Investment Fund, created by the legislature to ensure long-term sustainable funding.
