# 95 Delivers





The Alaska Legislature enacted the Alaska Performance Scholarship (APS) in 2011 to inspire and prepare high school students for success in college and career and technical training.

CLASS OF 2024: 3,745 Alaska high school graduates completed the rigorous requirements to achieve APS eligibility. 836 graduates used their award the fall after their graduation.




