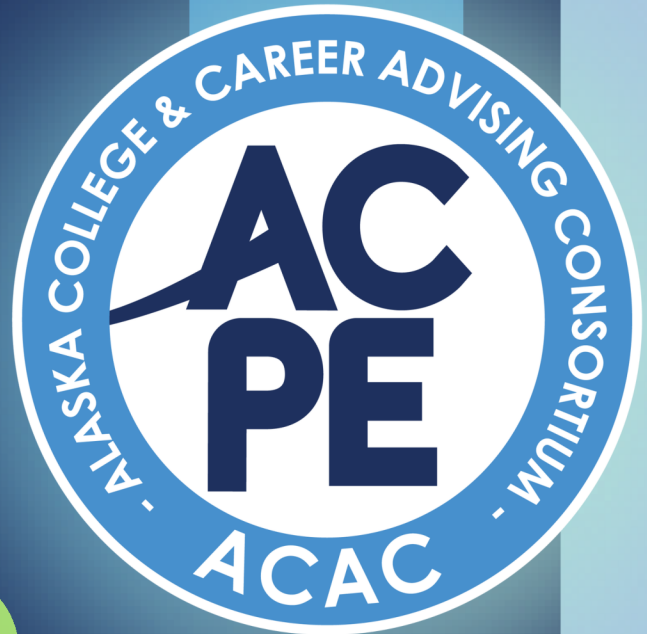

### Iḷisaġvik College



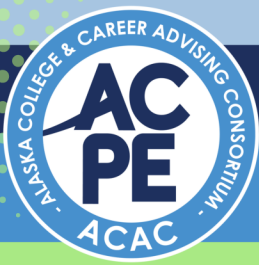
**Iḷisaġvik College**, the first and only federally recognized tribal college in Alaska, was founded to primarily serve the residents of the North Slope Borough, America's northernmost municipality. The basis for all of Iḷisaġvik's educational programs is the rich foundation of subsistence culture in harmony with the land and seas that give it sustenance.

The mission of Iḷisaġvik College is to provide quality postsecondary academic, career and technical education in a learning environment that perpetuates and strengthens Iñupiat culture, language, values, and traditions. It is dedicated to serving its students and developing a well-educated and trained workforce who meets the human resource needs of North Slope employers and the State of Alaska.

Iḷisaġvik College offers Bachelor's and Associate Degrees, Certificates, Endorsements, and Workforce Development credentials.

### Renewable Energy Alaska Project



Established in 2004, the **Renewable Energy Alaska Project (REAP)** is a non-profit organization dedicated to increasing the development of renewable energy and energy efficiency (“clean energy”) in Alaska through collaboration, education, training, and advocacy. REAP’s core objectives include:

- Energy education initiatives, such as K-12 STEM programming, workforce collaborations and trainings, and public events and presentations in a variety of venues
- Promoting energy efficiency
- Fostering and demonstrating stakeholder unity in support of renewable energy and energy efficiency in Alaska
- Developing and implementing policies to increase the production of renewable energy in Alaska
- Building a market in Alaska for renewable energy

## ACPE Student Loan (ASEL)

The **Alaska Supplemental (Student) Education Loan (ASEL)**, offered by ACPE, is a low-cost education loan option for Alaska’s students to use for postsecondary education or career training programs in Alaska or out-of-state. Currently rates are starting at 4.28% APR. To complete the application for the ASEL, students will need:

- Social Security Number (SSN)
- School Information
- Two references
- Financial aid information
- Cosigner name & email (if applicable)



During the loan application process, students may be asked to select a repayment type:

- Full Deferment – No payments while enrolled + grace period
- Immediate Repayment – Low fixed payments while enrolled
