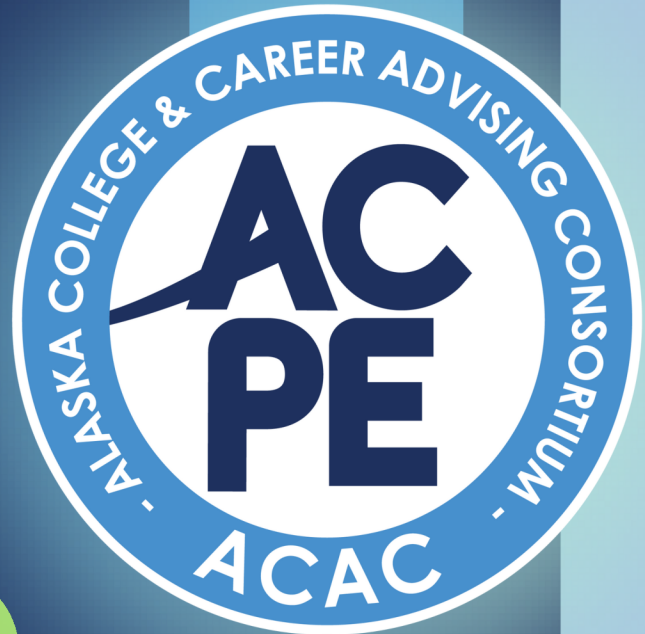

Alaska 529



Alaska 529 is an investment account specifically designed to help families save for education expenses in a tax-advantaged way. Any earnings are tax-deferred, and because individuals don't pay annual taxes on account earnings, their balance can grow faster than a taxable account over the same period. Earnings are also tax-free if used for qualified expenses. Alaska 529 funds can be used tax-free for education expenses at the following paths:

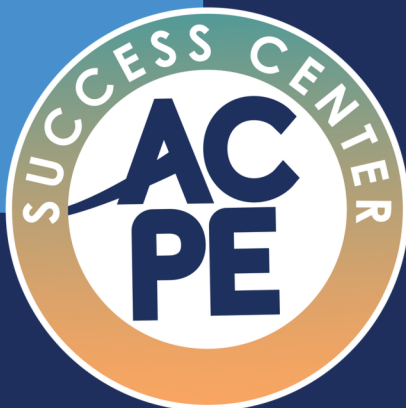
- K-12 Education
- College
- Apprenticeship
- Graduate School
- Vocational School
- Loan Repayment
- Postsecondary Credentials

Account owners maintain full control over their Alaska 529 account, including the flexibility to change their beneficiary at any time, without any annual fees or time restrictions. Additionally, after maintaining the Alaska 529 account for at least 15 years, owners can transfer funds to a Roth IRA for the beneficiary, free from taxes or penalties.
