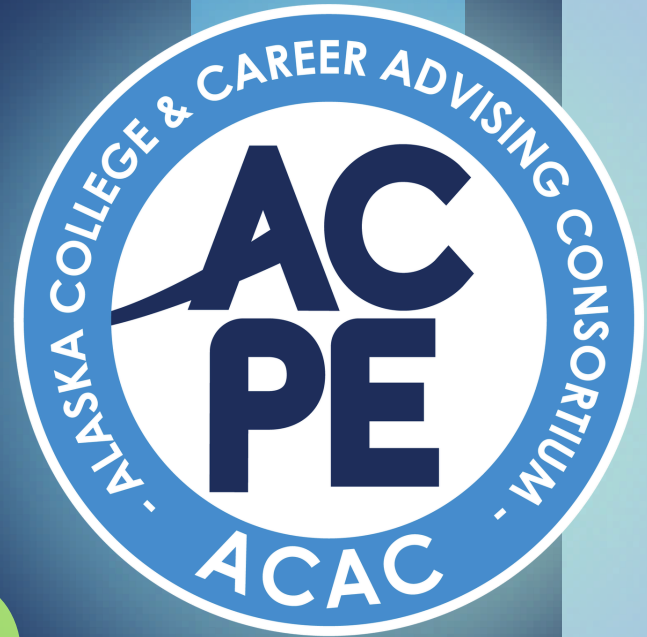

SERRC-Alaska's Educational Resource Center, created in 1976, is a non-profit service agency offering educational services across Alaska.

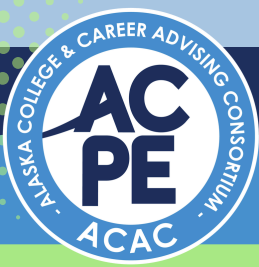
SERRC provides services to students and families, including summer and after school programs, career and technical education opportunities, camps for youth, postsecondary transition services, and adult education.

SERRC provides professional learning opportunities for Alaska's educators, supports special education, provides students and teacher chaperones with experiential learning opportunities and more.

SERRC offers a range of services to give school districts the benefit of a dedicated, experienced staff without having to funnel resources into full-time or multiple staff positions. Some districts replace specific roles with SERRC services, while other districts choose to contract with SERRC to augment existing services.

Div. of Employment & Training Services



The **Division of Employment & Training Services (DETS)** within the Alaska Department of Labor and Workforce Development (DOLWD), works with business and industry to build a trained and prepared workforce by providing labor exchange, employment and training services, and unemployment insurance to Alaskans and Alaska businesses, thereby advancing opportunities for employment and economic stability for communities in Alaska.

Examples of DETS services include:

- Oversight of state and federally funded programs providing job training and support services, job search, and relocation assistance
- Maintaining the Eligible Training Provider List (ETPL)
- Adult education and English literacy services for adults preparing for citizenship testing, or in need of a high school diploma or a GED certificate
- Oversight of 13 job centers across the state to assist job seekers with employment-related services
