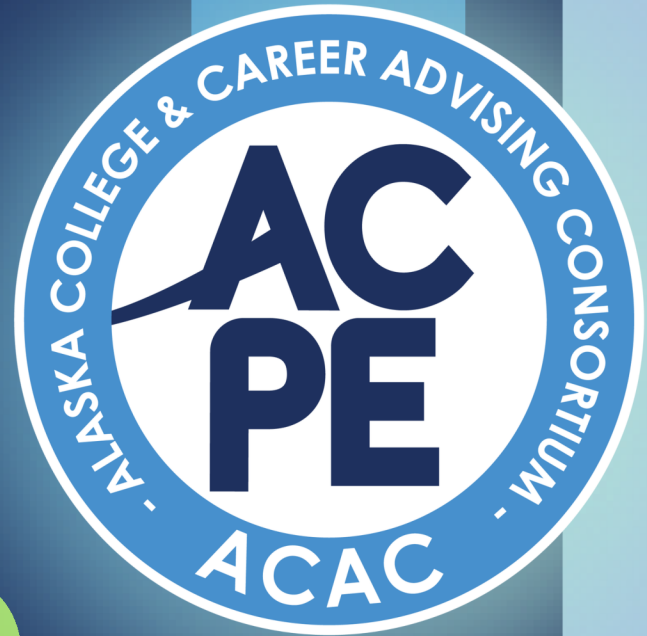

Northern Industrial Training



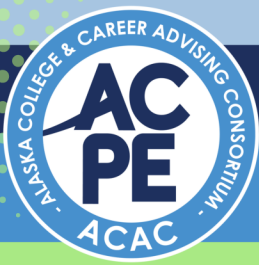

Division of Vocational Rehabilitation



The **Division of Vocational Rehabilitation (DVR)** within the Alaska Department of Labor and Workforce Development (DOLWD), assists Alaskans with physical, intellectual, or mental disabilities prepare for, get, and maintain good jobs.

A DVR counselor helps eligible job seekers set a job goal, choose the services they need to reach their goal, and select the providers for those services. The services used depend on the individual's needs, circumstances, and job goal.

Examples of free DVR services include:

- Help choosing the job goal that's a good fit
- Tests and other tools to assess skills and talents
- On-the-job training with a real employer
- A short-term job try-out
- Training and help adjusting to working
- Job search, placement, and tutoring services

ACPE Family Loan (FEL)

The **Alaska Family Education Loan (FEL)**, offered by ACPE, is a low-cost option for families to help cover student's education costs. The decision to pursue postsecondary education often involves various family members. With the Family Education Loan, the following family members may be eligible to borrow on behalf of a student:



- Spouse
- Parent
- Step-Parent
- Foster Parent
- Grandparent

The FEL has a fixed interest rate, which means once the rate is set, it remains the same throughout the life of the loan. Unlike other private lenders, there are no origination or prepayment fees on the FEL. Currently rates are starting at 5.75% APR.
