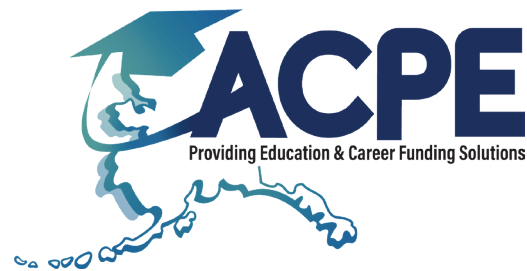


Alaska Education Grant (AEG)

Grant | money you don't need to pay back



Alaska's need-based grant aid available to eligible Alaska students.



How to Apply

Complete in **THREE EASY STEPS!**

STEP 1 Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at studentaid.gov and select at least one Alaska institution.

STEP 2 Create an Alaska Student Aid Portal (ASAP) account at acpe.alaska.gov/asap (scan QR code at the bottom of this page). Available funds are awarded to eligible applicants in priority order.

STEP 3 Confirmation of qualifying attendance by your school. Make sure you are fully admitted and enrolled **by August 1st**.

Award Summary

Thinking of how to pay for college or training? You may be eligible for up to **\$4,000**.

ANNUAL AWARD LEVELS

Up to \$3,000

if enrolled in at least 24 credits

Up to \$4,000

if enrolled in at least 30 credits
