APS Eligibility

APS ELIGIBILITY DEFINITIONS

INITIAL ELIGIBILITY = A student who meets APS eligibility requirements upon high school graduation.

CONTINUING ELIGIBILITY = After receiving their first two APS disbursements, students must meet specific requirements for future payments including minimum enrollment and GPA requirements.



CIRCUMSTANCE WHAT DO I DO NEXT? CONTACT

1. My counselor said I'm eligible for APS but my ASAP account says ineligible. What do I do?

INITIAL ELIGIBILITY

- If BEFORE AUGUST 15 of student's graduation year: Contact high school counselor to find out what APS eligibility was reported
- If AFTER ELIGIBILITY REPORT was sent to district: Check with district office (usually 3 business days after data received)

2. Why does my account say I'm ineligible for APS?

Student reviews ASAP account to determine if reason is based on SCHOOL CERTIFICATION:

- 3. I am eligible for a CTE award only and enrolled in courses but I am showing ineligible on ASAP.
- Differentiated Collegiate and CTE APS awards are for students who became eligible **PRIOR TO THE CLASS OF 2024** (after Class of 2024 there is no distinction between Collegiate & CTE APS awards)

4. Why am I showing ineligible due to residency status?



- Student Residency Requirement not met Update FAFSA
- Ineligibility due to residency status may be due to information entered on your FAFSA or how your postsecondary institution certified your eligibility.

5. Can I provide documentation that I'm eligible for APS?

INITIAL ELIGIBILITY • PUBLIC SCHOOL: Student attending Alaska public high schools

 PRIVATE HOME SCHOOL: Students attending private home school not associate with a school district (request "Private Home School Determination" application)

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6. I graduated in 2023 (or prior), can I now qualify for APS under the new requirements?	The new APS eligibility requirements are effective for the CLASS OF 2024 AND BEYOND (previous classes prior to 2024 are not APS eligible under the new requirements)	ACPE <u>or</u> DEED
7. I graduated in December. Why is my eligibility for APS not showing in ASAP?	ACPE does not receive high school eligibility until MID-AUGUST. Eligibility is not updated mid-year (watch your account on ASAP)	DEED
8. How can I qualify for an extension of my APS eligibility?	Contact ACPE	ACPE
9. Where can I send appeals or complaints related to eligibility?	Contact ACPE	ACPE

Ensure FAFSA is complete and submitted 2. Ensure FAFSA does not show need for additional documentation or verification • If (1) OR (2) is NOT verified, refer to FAFSA • If all is verified complete, refer to ASAP account for updates	FAFSA
3. When will funds be sent to my school? (Where is my money?)	ACPE does not disburse APS until the institution/ (Certifies) FAO has certified the student's enrollment. (Disperses Funds)	
4. I received APS last semester, why aren't I receiving it this semester?	Disbursement amount is based on (Certifies) FAO student enrollment certification. Contact the FAO at your institution (Disperses Funds)	→ FAO ACPE
5. Why was part or all of my APS disbursement sent back to ACPE?	Disbursement amount is based on FAO student enrollment certification. Contact the FAO at your institution	FAO
