ACPE Outreach Events and Success Center Update

ANCHORAGE – In consultation with statewide agencies and stakeholder groups, and out of an abundance of caution to protect students and communities across our state, the Alaska Commission on Postsecondary Education Success Center located in the Dimond Mall will temporarily be closed to walk-in services. Those in need of Success Center services are asked to call the Success Center staff at 907-269-7980 or email acpesuccesscenter@alaska.gov.

In conjunction with these measures, ACPE is cancelling larger in-person postsecondary outreach events for a minimum of 30 days. ACPE outreach personnel who coordinate these events, such as Kids2College and College & Career Panels, will collaborate with appropriate school and community contacts to discuss the potential of virtual-delivery options.

The Success Center closure and outreach event suspension will be reassessed after 30 days, or sooner, in light of any health and safety developments. ACPE is committed to providing postsecondary access and awareness programming for Alaskans and will continue to do so by utilizing appropriate and relevant delivery methods for our school districts and communities.
